Learning Objectives

- Know how to accomplish outdoor skills for Pack camping while fulfilling advancement requirements.
- Acquire the skills necessary for instructing Cub Scouts using the EDGE method (Explain, Demonstrate, Guide, Enable) the steps to lead, plan and carry out successful campouts.
- Increase leaders' knowledge of BSA outdoor skills resources.
- Demonstrate the outdoor skills necessary for basic BSA Family campouts.

The BSA requires that you have at least one BALOO-trained adult on every Cub Scout den or pack overnight outdoor event. That includes pack camping and Webelos den overnighters.

• You will not receive credit for the training if you are not present for the entire course or leave


early.

When you get into GJ, you will want to make your way to First and Grand, going West on Grand and through First St. [Shortly after you cross First St, Grand turns into Broadway]

Cross over the bridge that goes over the railroad tracks, then cross over the bridge that goes over the river and get into the right lane.

Just after you cross over the river bridge, there will be a stoplight. On your left will be Monument Rd, and on your right will be Dike Rd. (same road, different names) You will need to turn right at this light, onto Dike Rd. Keep right where Power Rd goes left. Take the first left, then an IMMEDIATE left into the property.

There will be our usual unconventional signage – please watch for it.
