

CUB SCOUT DAY CAMP



CUB SCOUT DAY CAMPS are multi-day programs that are age appropriate for all Cub Scouts. Day Camp participants will experience fun and exciting adventures while working on advancement. Trained volunteer leaders and parents conduct Day Camps under the direction of council leadership. All Day Camps are held at approved community locations during the day or early evening hours. Participants can attend Day Camp with their Cub pack, den or as an individual Scout with a parent. Tiger Cubs must attend with an adult partner. In addition to an exciting program, each Scout will receive a t-shirt, hat, water bottle and a patch.

A Mini Camp program is offered for potty trained siblings under the age of 10 at most Day Camp locations. Fees vary and are collected upon arrival. Parents/guardians of participants must be in camp each day their child attends Mini Camp.


