Rechartering is the annual process by which each Scouting unit renews its charter as an official part of the BSA. As part of rechartering, each Ward sends the BSA local council an updated noster of the Scouting unit, including the names, birth dates, and contact information of the registered youth in the unit. The roster lists all young men ages 8 through 15. Young men ages 16 and 17 are listed only if they are pursuing rank ad-Vancements or if the ward sponsors a Venturing Crew. The roster must be signed by a member of the bishopric.
