Introduction:

Welcome to the 2022 Majestic Mesas District Fall Rendezvous! This year's theme will be **"Knots and Shots"!** Come and enjoy a day of shooting, knot tying and service!

A little history of the Rendezvous:

"The rendezvous in general was pretty wild. Most were held in the valley of the Green River in what is now southwestern Wyoming and last about two weeks. Besides the trading, there was a lot of socializing to do. Traders, trappers, and the Indian customers, friends, and families, ate, drank, gambled, staged horse and foot races, quarreled, fought . . ." Tom Rea; Road to Rendezvous: the Rocky Mountain Fur Trade in 1934

The Rendezvous lasted each summer for about two weeks from 1825 to 1840 and trade goods (rifles, powder, traps, blankets, knives, tools, cloth, beads, etc) were traded for mostly beaver and sea otter pelts, as well as deer, bear, ermine and skunk pelts.

The three main companies that evolved were the Hudson's Bay Company (British), the Northwest Company (British) and the American Fur Company.
