National Youth Leadership Training – Individual Equipment Checklist Developed for Tahosa High Adventure Base

Each Scout is responsible for bringing the following items:

- □ Scout handbook. Patrol Leader hand book optional recommended. Pens/ pencils.
- □ Full class A Uniform
 - Official scout pants/shorts- 2 pair minimum
 - Scout Shirt with proper insignia- 2 recommend. Do not need merit badge or OA sashes.
 - Scout socks- min 2 pair
 - \circ Scout belt
- □ Or- Venturing or Sea Scout equivalent uniform
- Above the ankle, high top hiking boots **mandatory**. Water proof highly recommended.
- □ Personal tent (one scout per tent) and ground cloth- please be sure the scout has experience with set up and it is in good working condition. No cots please. There is no extra gear available.
- □ Sleeping pad, bag and pillow. Summer temperatures at altitude can be very cool. Plan accordingly.
- Large backpack. Scout will be carrying all their gear distances up to a mile to campsites and Outpost.
 Please pack efficiently as scouts will need to be hands free to do an activity on the way to their campsite.
- □ Day pack for 10 essentials. Do not bring fire starting material or trail food. No food or other smellables will be allowed in tents. Scouts will carry their 10 essentials at all times.
- □ Smaller bag, labeled with scout name, to store smellables in overnight bear boxes. Smellables include all types of toiletries. <u>No food</u> will be stored in overnight bear boxes.
- 1 large **CLEAR** water bottle. NO Camelbacks or metal bottles please.
- Good flashlight / headlamp with extra batteries. Consider bringing a backup.
- □ Regular watch with alarm- There is no cell / Wi-Fi service or battery charging area. Cell phones do not work as watches or alarm clocks. Please leave all electronics at home.
- Personal clothing items and toiletries <u>including shower items, towel and shower shoes</u>.
 - (underwear, sleeping clothes, toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, shampoo, bath towel, washcloth, deodorant- A Scout is Clean. Please plan accordingly and be respectful of your campmates.)
- □ Cold weather gear, coat, hat, gloves, sweatshirt. Evening and wet weather temperatures can be cold.
- □ Waterproof rain gear, jacket and pants recommended.
- □ Sunscreen, Lip Balm /sun protection, and insect repellent- scouts spend most of the day outside- sun protection is critical
- □ One bowl, cup and spoon for Outpost
- Pen and notebook
- □ Camera optional. Please do not bring expensive equipment. Camp is not responsible for loss or damage.

Big Horn provides the following:

One (1) NYLT Big Horn Hat, Two (2) activity uniform shirts, NYLT Big Horn songbook, and participant handbook. These are considered part of the NYLT uniform and are to be worn/carried at all times.

Please do <u>not</u> bring: neckerchief/ slide, sashes, sheath knives, pets, cellular phones, electronics including IPods or electronic games, any tobacco or alcohol products.
